In addition to my personal projects, often mixing in different forms of art, I collaborate with various artists as performer, composer and arranger spanning from theater, TV and discography (i.e. LaVerdi Symphony Orchestra of Milan, Anna Galiena, Gareth Somers, Leonardo Manera, OLOcreativeFarm, Susanna Parigi ...).

With M° Michele Masserano I am the owner of Jardin Musical,, an important music school in Ticino, Switzerland with headquarters in Morbio, Lugano and Bellinzona where I teach classical and electrical guitar as well as ensemble music.

Over the years I have been able to perform in television contexts (RAI and FININVEST networks) and in many of the most important Italian artistic realities: Milan (Auditorium Verdi, Teatro Piccolo, Castello Sforzesco, Blue Note), Bologna (Teatro Comunale, Teatro delle Erbe), Florence (Bargello Museum, Puccini theater), Rome (Teatro Ambra Jovinelli, Big Mama) just to name a few.

I collaborate with the symphonic orchestra LaVerdi with whom I perform several solo concerts playing both electric and classical guitar (“Concert for group & orchestra” by Jon Lord, “Pictures from an exhibition” in the prog version of Emerson Lake & Palmer, the “pluri-soldout” symphonic tributes to the Queen, Abba, Beatles, Pink Floyd... with over 10.000 spectators).
